#### WHITE WINE

<b>SANCERRE,</b> <i>Le Grand Rochoy Blanc, Domaine Laporte</i> Le Grand Rochoy is made exclusively from the oldest vines on a 2.5 hectare plot on the Domaine du Rochoy hillside. This is unique in the region of Sancerre for its flinty soil, which soaks up heat in the daytime and slowly re-radiates it at night. This wine is a pure expression of its origin and reveals an elegance and character quite unlike any other. It has exceptional keeping potential, of up to 10 years from vintage.		£89
<b>CHASSAGNE-MONTRACHET BLANC</b> , <i>Joseph Drouhin</i> An exotic, beguiling white Burgundy bursting with ripe tropical fruit, including pineapple and guava. Perfectly balanced by a concentrated jet of lime-flavoured acidity and a fragrance of spicy oak.		£168
<b>RIESLING</b> , <i>Trimbach</i> A full-bodied wine with intensity, depth, and a beautiful mineral flavour. Rich with a ripe acidity on the palate. A wine with great personality and finesse.	£15.5	£62
<b>MERSAULD,</b> <i>Domaine Jean-Michel Gaunoux</i> The wonderfully aromatic Meursault, featuring a creamy palate with hazelnut butter, yellow plum, and gingerbread. The flavour is complimented by floral notes of linden, chamomile, hawthorn, and a dollop of honey.		£135
<b>CHABLIS 1ER CRU</b> , <i>Bernard Defaix</i> This Premier Cru is the perfect illustration of the minerality in Chablis. Gun flint and saltiness are the reflections of soil full of stones and fossils.		£68
<b>POUILLY-FUMÉ LES BERTHIERS</b> , <i>J-C Dagueneau</i> Pouilly Fume Domaine des Berthiers Jean-Claude Dagueneau , smokey, crisp, classic Loire Valley Sauvignon. A fine example of the appellation, with rich, fruity, red apple and grapefruit flavours, backed up by smokiness and crisp acidity. The wine itself sees a short period of skin contact before being slowly cold fermented for 3-4 weeks. It is then aged on the fine lees to give the wine added richness and some of that distinctive smokiness.		£83
<b>POUILLY-FUISSÉ</b> , <i>Domaine Beranger</i> Notes of of lime, lemongrass and almonds on the nose, complemented by further nutty flavours on the palate. Round, ample and fruity.		£86
<b>PULIGNY-MONTRACHET LES LEVRONS</b> , <i>Lucien Le</i> The deep stony soil gives the wine its intensity and elegance typical of the land around Puligny. Aromas are floral with hints of almond and hazelnut and the wine is fresh and rich in the mouth		£205
<b>CHÂTEAUNEUF-DU-PAPE BLANC MAGIS</b> , <i>R&amp;M Saouma</i> An arresting nose of grilled nuts, sesame, citrus and blossom, and an equally impressive palate that manages to deliver power and breadth yet retain a sense of grace. Ageworthy and structured, with echoes of burgundy but very much its own sense of style, this is remarkable white Châteauneuf.		£188

<b>PINOT GRIGIO,</b> <i>Sartori</i> Pinot Grigio from Italy's northern village of Sartori, with a lightly floral bouquet and an unusually rich, concentrated mouth, with ripe pineapple, melon, and a whiff of herbs.		£42
<b>VERMENTINO VILLA SOLAIS,</b> <i>Santadi</i> Terricciola's soil is sandy and rich in marine sediments, which gives our Vermentino an incredibly aromatic profile. The wine has notes of Mediterranean scrub blended with mineral and white flower scents. The flavours are a perfect match of fresh and savoury.	£12	£44
MASSICCIO VERDICCHIO DEI CASTELLI DI JESI Classico Superiore, Fazi Battaglia Rich, concentrated Verdicchio. A dry yet honeyed flavour, bursting with scents of golden apples, perfumed with nuts and Mediterranean herbs, with a finishing flourish of bitter almond.		£72
GAVI DI GAVI MINAIA, <i>Nicola Bergaglio</i> A fruity, people-pleasing white from northern Italy. Flowers, almonds and hazelnuts and a streak of flint keep this flavour interesting.		£55
VETTE SAUVIGNON BLANC, <i>Tenuta San Leonardo</i> Vette is named for the imposing peaks that rise above its Sauvignon Blanc vineyard, and it is the true height of refreshing crispness and earthy minerality.	£13	£52
<b>BRAMITO CHARDONNAY</b> , <i>Castello della Sala, Antinori</i> Bramito is produced from the vineyards surrounding the medieval castle at Castello della Sala. One variety that thrives in this terroir is Chardonnay. The vineyards are on soils rich in fossil deposits with veins of clay that give the wine minerality and elegance.	£17	£67
<b>CERVARO DELLA SALA</b> , <i>Antinori</i> A blend of Chardonnay grapes and a small quantity of Grechetto make a wine that can age over time and represent the elegance and complexity of this unique estate. Cervaro della Sala is one of the first Italian white wines to have malolactic fermentation and ageing take place in barriques.		£160

<b>ALBARINO DO RIAS BAIXAS,</b> <i>Mar de Frades</i> Fresh, sparkly Albariño from rainy Galicia in northern Spain, balances salt and citrus with tropical fruit. The mango, pineapple and lychee soften the lime and greengages, resulting in a pleasing, food-friendly whole-bodied wine.		£60
RIOJA ORGANZA BLANCO RESERVA Vinedos Sierra Cantabria This herbaccous white Rioja is powerfully fragrant with an alluring blend of beeswax, nutmeg, and		£92
tropical fruit; in the mouth, there are wild herbs and a refreshing tang of grapefruit.		
<b>LA DOMAINE WHITE,</b> <i>Abadia Retuerta</i> A rounded Spanish white, with the sharp juiciness of grapefruit and apple softened by flavours of honey, preserved peaches, and an exotic waft of ginger.		£135
<b>CONDE VALDEMAR RIOJA BLANCO FINCA ALTO</b> A successful blend of modern fruit and traditional oak ageing: lemony, smoke and vanilla scented, with subtle aromas of peaches and apricot, and beautifully balanced.		£67

<b>MELODIAS</b> , <i>Winemakers Selection, Chardonnay, Trapiche</i> Pears and crème brûlée make a delicious combination in this Argentinian Chardonnay, which is scented with lemon blossom and brioche.		£46
<b>FRANKLAND RIVER RIESLING</b> , <i>Swinney</i> Exceptionally aromatic Riesling from Western Australia, heady with lemon sherbet, jasmine blossom, and grapefruit - leaving the mouth with hints of lime, lychee, and lemon myrtle.		£72
<b>PINOT GRIS</b> , <i>Peregrinewines</i> Textured Pinot Gris from New Zealand, packed with apricots and nectarines, the sweetness of elderflower and tang of ginger on the nose balanced by a fine, fresh spray of citrus.		£88
<b>ROUXVALE SAUVIGNON BLANC</b> , <i>Robertson</i> , <i>South Africa</i> outh African Sauvignons are less explosive in flavour than the well-known zingy New Zealand new world examples with a little more body. This Sauvignon will still give you a delicious, flavour-packed journey of apple, kiwi fruits, lemon and lime and subtle elderflower.	£12	£42
<b>THE FMC,</b> <i>Chenin, Ken Forrester wines</i> The pinnacle of what we consider to be the finest expression of the grapes of this varietal - an icon chenin, a challenge to the world! <b>CÔTES DU RHÔNE ROUGE,</b> <i>Fontaine du Clos</i> Subtle but approachable Côtes du Rhône, holds a flavour filled with red berries, raspberries, redcurrants and strawberries - on the nose and the palate.	£13	£50
<b>PINOT NOIR</b> , <i>Joseph Drouhin</i> Pinot is a wine with aromas of red fruit, raspberries, and currants. On the palate it is spicy and pleasantly silky. It is a balanced wine, without too much power and with a medium-low acidity.	£15	£60

This sophisticated Rhône Syrah combines savoury fruit flavours with tar, leather, and a touch of spicy oak.		
<b>CHATEAU TALBOT,</b> <i>Saint-Julien 2014</i> Wonderful Grand Cru, the nose is already open with expressive notes of aniseed, cinnamon, and blackcurrant. The palate shows good structure, concentration, and vivacity with a remarkably aromatic and long-lasting finish.		£245
<b>CHÂTEAUNEUF-DU-PAPE LE PARVIS</b> , <i>Ferraton</i> complex, aromas of morello cherries and plums, with hints of roasted coffee and cinnamon. Palata, fine and smooth tannins. Fleshy and long-lasting wine.		£108
<b>NUITS-ST-GEORGES VIEILLES VIGNES</b> , <i>Alain Michelot</i> All the richness of old vines of at least 45 years of age, gives this powerful, aromatic Nuits-Saint-Georges a wonderful texture, complex flavours of blackberry, blackcurrant and smoke, and a long, elegant flavoursome finish.		£143
<b>GEVREY-CHAMBERTIN</b> , <i>Henri de Villamont</i> A ruby colour with note of wood, then it reveals fruity notes like blackberry at the nose. This is an elegant wine.		£160
<b>HERMITAGE LES MIAUX ROUGE</b> , <i>Ferraton</i> Complex aromas of blueberry, licorice and violet with dusty minerals notes. Full bodied and chewy on the palate with intense flavours of ripe blackberry fruits and hints of spice.		£172
<b>CHÂTEAU LANGOA-BARTON</b> , <i>Saint-Julien</i> This vintage is a picture of generosity, a portrait of sensual delight, of silky serenity. The nose tingles with aromatic herbs: wild thyme and Summer savoury along with a touch of graphite. The palate, with its deep, lingering flavours, is an accumulation of strength. Then the well-tamed tannins finish tenderly, caressed by the velvet touch of the almost imperceptible oak.		£190

Beautifully fine tannins surround a mighty, meaty, focused core of fresh, ripe blackberries and red fruit, all dancing around your palate vying for your attention.		
<b>CHATEAU BERTINAT LARTIGUE</b> , 2016 Sait-emilion Radiant garnet colour with a nose of dark cherry and oak. Smooth tannins and slightly acidic. Dark plum and berry with some leather flavours with a Merlot influence. If you can't be in St Emilion then open a bottle and enjoy with a tangy salad and French lentils and chicken.		£60
CHATEAU GRAND PEYRON GRAN CRU, 2016 Saint-emilion	ı	£80
Chateau Grand Peyrou St-Emilion Grand Cru is made from 40 year old vines on a small family owned two hectare estate. An aromatic nose of cinnamon and blackcurrant. Good weight in the mouth with mature concentrated fruit, cedar notes and a long finish.

<b>BAROLO DI SERRALUNGA</b> , <i>D'Alba DOGC</i> , <i>Fontanafredda</i> Full-bodied, velvety, and intense - this Barolo is heady with vanilla, dried Rosés and woodland undergrowth.		£125
AMARONE CLASSICO DOC, <i>Bertani</i> A silky Amarone - the rich, textured dry red of the Veneto. Like a savoury port, with flavours of prunes, Morello cherries and a heady bouquet of nuts, tobacco, dried flowers, and sweet spices.		£265

<b>BARBARESCO,</b> <i>Prunotto</i> Barbaresco is an intense garnet red color. Its nose is complex with aromas of red fruit and spicy notes. The palate is full and velvety with a persistent finish.		£88
<b>GUADO AL TASSO,</b> <i>Antinori</i> A blend of Cabernet Sauvignon, Merlot, Cabernet Franc and occasionally a small amount of Petit Verdot to best represent the complexity and elegance.		£240
<b>SAN LEONARDO,</b> <i>Tenuta San Leonardo</i> The iconic wine of the estate, with its roots deep in its centuries-old history. A classic Bordeaux blend of breed, aristocratic elegance, and extraordinary longevity.		£180
<b>TIGNANELLO,</b> <i>Antinori</i> Tignanello was the first Sangiovese to be aged in barriques, the first contemporary red wine blended with untraditional varieties (specifically Cabernet) and one of the first red wines in the Chianti Classico region that didn't use white grapes. Tignanello is a milestone. It's produced with a selection of Sangiovese, Cabernet Sauvignon and Cabernet Franc.		£255

<b>RESERVA</b> , <i>Pago de Los Capellanes</i> Swirling scents of cherry, blackcurrant, and plum, meld elegantly on the palate with spice, vanilla, cacao, and a touch of liquorice		£159
<b>MACÁN</b> , <i>Rothschild/Vega Sicilia</i> This is not traditional Rioja, Macán and Macán Clásico are not blends of various terroirs but aim to express one particular terroir – that of San Vicente de la Sonsierra in Rioja Alta.		£163
